5 - Right to participate

The event is open to competitors of any state, nation or foreign federation.

As for Italian competitors: the participation to the event is allowed only to FIJLKAM affiliated athletes and EPS who have signed an agreement with FIJLKAM.

All competitors must show a legal passport of the nation they represent in the competition.

Medical certificate, insurance, gender control and the like are placed under responsibility of the club registering the competitor.

6 - Categories

Competitors will reach the age in the present year (from 1st January to 31st December).

Open d'Italia - Duo and Show

Competitors will be divided by age:

Masters (>40)

Adults (>21) + Master M1 (<40)

U21 (18÷20)

U18 (16÷17)

U16 (14÷15)

U14 (12÷13)

All the age categories will be divided as follows: Man, Women, Mix. An athlete is allowed to compete in the next higher age category. A competitor shall participate in no more couples than two, but not in the same category (e.g. in two team of different age or in man/women team and mix team) *only if it doesn't hinder the correct course of the competition.*

Open d'Italia - Fighting System and Ne Waza

Athletes will compete following the divisions:

Adults (>21) + Master (<40) M:[Kg] -56 -62 -69 -77 -85 -94 +94

F: [Kg] -45 -48 -52 -57 -63 -70 +70

U21 (18÷20) M:[Kg] -56 -62 -69 -77 -85 -94 +94

U18 (16÷17) M:[Kg] -46 -50 -55 -60 -66 -73 -81 +81

F:[kg] -40 -44 -48 -52 -57 -63 -70 +70

U16 (14÷15) M:[Kg] -38 -42 -46 -50 -55 -60 -66 -73 +73

F:[kg] -32 -36 -40 -44 -48 -52 -57 -63 +63

U14 (12÷13) M:[Kg] -30 -34 -38 -42 -46 -50 -55 -60 -66 +66

F: [Kg] -25 -28 -32 -36 -40 -44 -48 -52 -57 +57

Only for Ne Waza speciality, the competition is open also to Master with more than 40 years, that will fight in a unique age category.

Children Grand Prix – Fighting system

Following divisions will be applied:

U12 (2008÷2009): M:[Kg] -24 -27 -30 -34 -38 -42 -46 -50 +50

F:[Kg] -22 -25 -28 -32 -36 -40 -44 -48 +48

U10 (2010÷2011): M:[Kg] -21 -24 -27 -30 -34 -38 -42 +42

F:[Kg] -20 -22 -25 -28 -32 -36 -40 +40

U8 (2012÷2014): M:[Kg] -18 -20 -22 -24 -26 -28 -30 -32 -34 -36 -38 +38

7 - Trophies

All the first three athletes in each category will be awarded with medals.

There will be a trophy for the best five clubs in the Open d'Italia overall competition (Fighting + Ne-Waza + Duo + Show);

There will be a trophy for the best three clubs in the Children Grand Prix overall competition.

8 - Competition rules

General rules

FIJLKAM rules will apply (edition 4 - Luglio 2019 (http://bit.ly/JJOPEN_rules)).

Fighting time

Fighting system: U8, U10, U12, U14, U16: 2 min (U8: time runs also between mate and hajime)
U18, U21 e Adults: 3 min

Ne Waza: U14, U16: 3 min. U18: 4 min. U21: 5 min. Adults: 6 min. Master: 5 min

Rules limitations

Duo

U14 & U16 will perform only the first two series. The three attacks for each series are drawn by MR.

Fighting System

U8 competition is limited only to second and third part, therefore gloves and shinbone protectors are not requested.

Categories U8, U10 and U12: Following dangerous actions are forbidden (sanctioned with *chui*): any atemi to the head (including circular attacks), dangerous throws (lifting techniques, techniques with both knees on floor, maki-komi, sutemi-waza – except tani otoshi that is allowed and scored-, techniques with grip on trousers, throwing the opponent with a clinch on the neck without a proper grip to the Gi, throwing the opponent with both arms are trapped, falling without control on the opponent), perform any lock or choke.

U14 and U16: Following dangerous actions are forbidden (sanctioned with *Chui*): atemi attack touching the head of the opponent in a hard way, perform locks or chokes in second part, perform a leg lock. If strangulations and/ or Locks will be executed in a technical correct way, with perspective of submission effect, the referee must stop the fight by announcing “Matte”.

Ne Waza

In addition to the higher categories limitations, U14 and U16 cannot perform chokes affecting the spinal column (Ezequiel, guillotine,...), cannot perform locks or compression using the legs (omoplata, do jime,...), cannot perform leg locks.

In addition to Adult limitations, U18 are not allowed to perform wrist-locks, biceps/calf slicer, hiza-juji gatame and foot locks.

9 - Athletes: dress and protectors

The only Gi colour allowed is white. Female competitors are required to wear a plain white T-shirt or leotard under their Gi. Men are not allowed to wear anything under their Gi-jacket.

Fighting System: protectors requested by competition rules are mandatory.

U8, U10, U12, U14, U16: the use of mouthpiece is mandatory (facultative for higher categories).
U14 and U16: female chest protector and male groin protector (soft material) is requested.

10 - Coach

Only one coach is allowed to assist the athletes. Every 6 athletes, an additional coaches is allowed. Every coach must be adult and registered in the subscription form, wear club suit and follow FIJLKAM regulations. Every coach will receive a pass that must be shown during the whole competition. Additional coaches are allowed only to assist the athlete during a match.

Only the official coach is entitled to represent the club, attending to accreditation and weighing procedures or ask an official complain.

It is a duty of coaches to verify that their competitors will be ready for the fight, with proper dressing and protectors/weapons, in order to avoid any punishment (from shido to walkover).

Only one coach per competitor is allowed. A competitor cannot be assisted by another competitor or a referee.

11 - Doctor

An official doctor will attend to the event –eventually assisted by another doctor- together with paramedics. The first aid is matter of official doctor in case of injury or illness, is not allowed to any other doctor or coach to give first aid to an athlete, except under authorization of official doctor.

If the official doctor declares that a competitor cannot continue is final and cannot be appealed, not even by another Doctor attending the competition.

12 - Referees

Italian referees must comply with FIJLKAM membership.

We would kindly ask all participating clubs to provide at least one referee. Referees sould register with Stefano Qualich (qualich@gmail.com), with name and license (duo/fighting/ne waza).

Registration fee. Italian Open registration fees are as follows:

Duo System: 20 €/couple

Duo Show: 20 €/couple

Fighting System: 20 €/athlete

Ne Waza: 20 €/athlete

Children Grand Prix (U8, U10, U12) fee will be 15 €/athlete.

Both registrations and payments must be received *no later than 24th November*.

Registration/Payment to Italian Open after that deadline will be accepted with 10 € surcharge.

14 - Accreditation and weighting procedure

Accreditation

The coach will present copy of the registration forms for the athletes of their own club (already sent in due time to the organization), the certificate of payment of the registration fees of all the athletes present on the form, the liability statement signed (last page of this invitation) The verification of the attending athletes will be carried out.

Weighing procedure

Weighing will be made both for Italian Open and for Children Grand Prix. A copy of the athletes registration form, verified and signed during accreditation, will be brought by the coach to the weighing area, where he will attend with all his athletes.

All athletes will show a valid ID document and ready for the weighing.

The minimum acceptable clothing is a t-shirt and shorts covering the knee. No Weight tolerance is allowed!

Warning! Fighting System and Duo Show draws will take place Saturday 7th, 10 PM, at Official Hotel: therefore athletes attending Sunday weighing and resulting out of category will not compete.

15 - Cancellation policy

The organiser reserves the right to cancel the event due Red weather alert, to low enrolment or regulations or other circumstances which would make the event not viable. If the organiser cancels the event, registrants will be offered a full refund based on their full registration fee. Should circumstances arise that result in the postponement of an event, the organiser has the right to either issue a full refund or transfer registration to the same event at the new, future date. The organisation is not liable for other costs.

International airport "Cristoforo Colombo" (GOA) is served by main Italian and foreign Airlines, as well as many low-cost airlines.

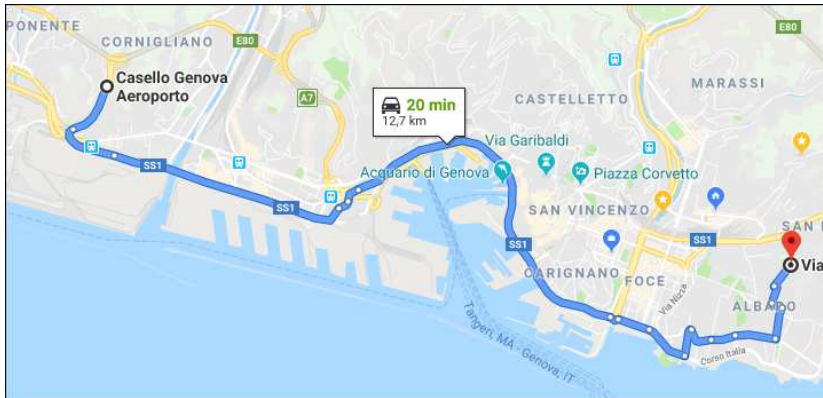
Train / Bus

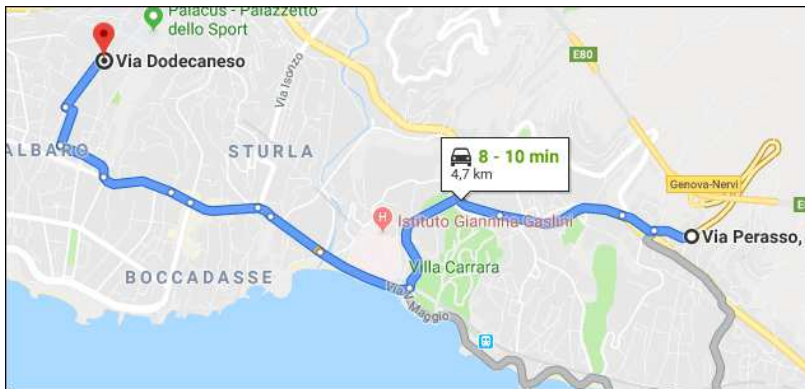

Incoming from A12 (Genova - Rosignano Marittimo), exit at Genova Nervi, then proceed in Corso Europa following direction Centro, Val Bisagno, Val Polcevera. After 4.3 km, turn left in via Corridoni, then proceed in Via Monte Zovetto arriving in Piazza Leonardo da Vinci. Turn left in via

Boselli. At next traffic light, turn left in Via Guerrazzi, then left in via Pisa. At second cross-road, turn right in via Flora, then proceed right in via Dodecaneso.

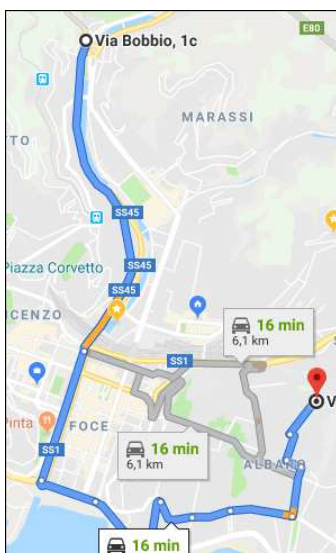

Incoming from A10 (France), exit at Genova Aeroporto, follow Centre City indications, using Guido Rossa street, then continue on elevated road Aldo Moro. At the roundabout, follow Corso Marconi and then Corso Italia. After 1.7 km turn left in via Campanella. At traffic light, turn left and suddenly turn right in via

Guerrazzi. At the end of via Guerrazzi, turn in via Pisa. At second crossroad, turn left in via Flora and then continue in via Dodecaneso.

incoming from A7: Follow indications for Fiera di Genova. Once arrived, at roundabout turn right following Corso Marconi and then Corso Italia. After 1.7 km turn left in via Campanella.
